

EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING 2


Notice is hereby given that an **Extraordinary General Meeting** of The Institute of Measurement and Control will take place at 297 Euston Road, London, NW1 3AD, 16:08 4th July, for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, passing the following resolution:

'That as from the 1st day of January 2025 the annual subscription payable by members of the Institute pursuant to Bye-law 13(i) shall increase by no more than 3.5% over the 2024 levels, at the final discretion of the Board of Trustees.'

(Note: The resolution may not be amended during the meeting but must be either carried or rejected as it stands.)

The EGM will be held face to face, but the Trustees have confirmed that the meeting will be available to view virtually by members unable to physically attend. In accordance with the Bye laws eligible members who are not able to physically attend are entitled to submit their votes by proxy ahead of the meeting.
